Expungement Clinic

Our first in-person expungement clinic since the start of the pandemic will be held Tuesday, September 21 at the Italian Community Center in downtown Kenosha.

In partnership with the State Bar of Wisconsin, Wisconsin Association of African American Lawyers, the Kenosha County Bar Association, Foley & Ladner LLP and the Urban League of Racine Kenosha.

Legal Action staff with about 30 volunteers from its partner organizations plan to serve about 100 low-income Wisconsinites from the underserved communities in and around Kenosha. The partners also plan to use this event to highlight the importance of civil legal services and pro bono in promoting access to justice and removing barriers to employment.
